This year has quickly come to an end. On the Pacific Hope it was a year of growth, preparation, and learning. It feels like this ministry has been amping up and getting ready to really take off I am very excited to see what God has in store overview of 2019.

My Year at a Glance

<u>Jan - Feb:</u> Shipyard maintenance period. I took some training courses and earned my 100-ton inland waters captain license.

March: We sailed back to Dominica and did ministry.

April: Ministry in Dominica. Prepared for ship to arrive in Dominican Republic.

May: Sailed to Dominican Republic and started Ministry

June: Ran clinics and other ministry in the Dominican Republic

July & August: Had youth teams on board doing ministry in Dominican Republic.

<u>Sept:</u> Sailed to the Bahamas and began relief efforts in Freeport. Had a remote team deployed to work on Grand Cay. They opened clinic and treated patients, helped get the watermaker back up, provided food, among other things.

<u>Oct:</u> The ship joined the remote team on Grand Cay. We continued operating the clinic, started a program for the island's kids, distributed supplies, & started reroofing homes. <u>Nov & Dec:</u> We continued reroofing houses and distributing supplies on Grand Cay.
